Hey friends – just a couple quick notes this month:

First, as you're reading this, you'll notice that we're halfway through our 2020 Vision series about our new Vision: **THE WHOLE COMMUNITY WHOLE IN CHRIST**

I hope this series is challenging you like it is me to find greater wholeness in Christ and to share that with someone else. Over the next year (or more) you're going to see some small incremental changes as we align our ministries to this vision. I simply want to encourage you to seek greater wholeness in your life and if – over the next several months (or even years) – you see something happen in our corporate church life that raises questions for you, to ask those questions of one of our leaders. We request the opportunity to explain why we're making these changes, as I assure you that none of them are without intention.

If you've put all the pieces together, you've realized that I'll be out of the pulpit for six weeks in a row. That was NOT my intention or plan when I mapped out 2018 last year, but God worked it out so that this can happen right after we have a baby. How cool is that?! Anyway, I want to assure that even though I'm not in the pulpit, I'm working hard behind the scenes to help the with Vision alignment I spoke of above.
