Wow, it is really heating up around here! OK, well, maybe not outside, but the life and activity here at Chapel Rock is really picking up the pace! Let me update you on a few really important things: First, I hope you all have heard the announcement and good news that John Noel has rejoined the staff at Chapel Rock! John was the Children's Pastor here back in the late 80s and early 90s, and then left to go serve in pastoral care ministry at Kingsway Christian Church and Connection Pointe Christian Church. A few years ago (post-COVID), he retired. However, over the last several months he had begun to feel like, in his words, "I think I've got one more in me" and was looking for a part-time, pastoral care-related role, at a local church that he and his wife Gail already knew and loved. Not coincidentally, we were looking for someone just like John! So, this is a total God thing, and a perfect fit for the Noel's and us. We are super excited to have John back on our staff here at Chapel Rock! One of the things he's so passionate about is something called Steven Ministry, which is a program designed to train the members of the church to provide pastoral care to each other! You're going to hear more about that this fall.

Second, the planning stage of our big overhaul of the audio system in the auditorium is over, and we are beginning to put those plans into action. In fact, by the time you read this, there will likely already be some paint on the wall. It won't be long after that that some of the acoustic treatments will begin to arrive, and in another couple months, we're going to have some new speakers in there. Again, I want to take this opportunity to express gratitude on behalf of the Elders to the member who gave this gift to enable us to do this! Finally, I am so excited about the sermon series we're starting in February that will take us up to Easter. It's a series called, "Failing Forward," and we're going to be spending the next couple of months in the Gospel of Mark. One of Mark's significant themes is looking at how the 12 Apostles are ... well, knuckleheads. It's interesting, because most scholars think the apostle Peter is Mark's main source of information for writing his Gospel. Over and over again in Mark, he shows how the Twelve just don't get it; and yet, these twelve men are those who Jesus used to change the world! That gives me hope for myself! It's my prayer that it's going to do the same for you. I know you're going to get so much out of this next series as we think about how Jesus has been redeeming shenanigans and tomfoolery since AD 30. Be sure to be here and invite a friend!
