Vision Casting Series Week 3

Introduction

Family Worship is an opportunity to meet together with your loved ones and dig deeper into the Scripture by examining principles presented in this week's sermon. These are not intended to be long devotional sessions. Instead, we hope to simply prompt a few minutes of Gospel-centered conversation with your family and to give you some tools to reinforce what you hear on Sunday throughout the week. The Sunday Worship Gathering is not where worship begins, but is where you join with fellow believers in a continuation of your individual worship.

Discussion Questions

- » Several passages (Acts 20:24; Hebrews 12:1, etc) use running as an description of the Christian life. What does it mean to "run with endurance" - does this merely mean to "endure" life, or something else entirely?
- » Read Philippians 2:1-4
 - » What does it mean to be like-minded with other believers? Should believers always agree on everything? Will they?
 - » How can you look toward the interests of others more than your own? What is one area where you can choose to be uncomfortable for the sake of showing the love of Christ?
- » Looking forward to this week's sermon, read Ephesians 2:10. What does it mean to regard other people as God's workmanship? How should that affect how we view foreigners, refugees, and other marginalized people?
