## Introduction

Family Worship is an opportunity to meet together with your loved ones and dig deeper into the Scripture by examining principles presented in this week's sermon. These are not intended to be long devotional sessions. Instead, we hope to simply prompt a few minutes of Gospel-centered conversation with your family and to give you some tools to reinforce what you hear on Sunday throughout the week. The Sunday Worship Gathering is not where worship begins, but is where you join with fellow believers in a continuation of your individual worship.

## Discussion Questions

» Ephesians 2:10 tells us that we are created to serve God. How then can we find fulfillment in life? Is true satisfaction possible if one is not serving God?

» Read Psalm 51:15-16 and 2 Corinthians 9:7

» What does it mean that God desires a broken and contrite heart more than sacrifice? In the context of 2 Corinthians 9:7, does God desire mere works, or an attitude of service?

» How can you adjust your attitude toward serving others? Does your heart reflect your actions, or do you view service as an obligation, rather than a response to salvation?

» Looking forward to this week's sermon, read 2 Corinthians 5:20. What does it mean to be an ambassador of Christ? How does your life reflect the kingdom of God to those who are around you?
