Introduction

Family Worship is an opportunity to meet together with your loved ones and dig deeper into the Scripture by examining principles presented in this week's sermon. These are not intended to be long devotional sessions. Instead, we hope to simply prompt a few minutes of Gospel-centered conversation with your family and to give you some tools to reinforce what you hear on Sunday throughout the week. The Sunday Worship Gathering is not where worship begins, but is where you join with fellow believers in a continuation of your individual worship.

Discussion Questions

» Psalm 96:2 commands us to proclaim God's salvation every day. In what ways can you do so in your daily life? Do you have opportunities to praise God and declare salvation, even in unexpected times or places?

» Read Acts 4:11-13.

» Peter and John spoke with great confidence before the Sanhedrin. From where did this confidence come? Do we have access to the same confidence today?

» Verse 13 describes Peter and John as ordinary men. How should this give us freedom when we seek to share the gospel with others?

» Looking forward to this week's sermon, read Acts 2:42-47. How is the worship described in this passage different from what we consider worship today?
