Introduction

Family Worship is an opportunity to meet together with your loved ones and dig deeper into the Scripture by examining principles presented in this week's sermon. These are not intended to be long devotional sessions. Instead, we hope to simply prompt a few minutes of Gospel-centered conversation with your family and to give you some tools to reinforce what you hear on Sunday throughout the week. The Sunday Worship Gathering is not where worship begins, but is where you join with fellow believers in a continuation of your individual worship.

Discussion Questions

- » 2 Peter 3:18 tells Christians to grow in the grace and knowledge of Christ. How should we pursue consistent growth throughout our lives? Does this period of growth ever end?
- » Read Luke 14:27-33.
 - » What is the central point of this passage? Does Christ suggest that the Christian life is easy, or difficult?
 - » What does it mean to "give up everything you have" to be a disciple of Christ?
 - » What do you need to give up in order to fully follow Christ, holding nothing back?
- » Looking forward to this week's sermon, read Mark 16:15. What does it mean to preach the good news to all creation? To whom is this passage addressed?
