When the envy bug bites and I'm tempted to think God is withholding his goodness from me, I speak truth with these four verses. I pray they will strengthen you too as you fight your good fight of faith.

TO USE: 1. Print this page, 2. Trim off this top, 3. Fold the page into quarters, 4. Place the page in a ziploc baggie, and 4. Take it and read it aloud when you go on a walk or drive in your car.

If you read them aloud daily, they will settle. Then the Holy Spirit can bring them to mind to extinguish the enemy's fiery envy darts.
