Mon., Apr. 23rd: Luke 18:18-43

Jesus teaches, predicts His death and heals a man in this passage. Dig into the character of Christ in the RightNow Media study "Everyday Jesus" by Pete Briscoe.

Jesus' character is dynamic and displays emotions not commonly associated with Him. If we're unaware of the diversity of His personality, we'll miss out on His fullness and our experience of Him will be limited.

Tues., Apr. 24th: Luke 19:1-28

Jesus knew him and called him by name, Jesus knows you & calls you by name, Jesus was willing to move toward the brokenness and mess in order to pull a man closer to God, are you? the man desired to live with integrity. But it is important to keep our priorities straight. This was a loaded question. The Jews were enraged at having to pay taxes to Rome, thus supporting the pagan government. They hated the system that allowed tax collectors to charge exorbitant rates and keep the extra for themselves.”
