

Volunteer & Leader Team

Creating an environment filled with love for your child cannot begin if we do not first have a team of enthusiastic leaders and volunteers who have a heart on fire for helping your child grow.

Safety Checks

Each volunteer or leader in the Children's Wing will go through a background check which is ran through a national database. As well as referenced and interviewed by the Children's Ministry Director. Please see Calvary Baptist Church Sexual Abuse Policy for further details.

All volunteers must observe the "two nonrelated adult" rule. This rule requires that adults are never alone with children or youth without another adult partner present. All classroom and office doors have windows to allow visibility in the classroom or office at all times. All church staff and regular volunteers who work with children or youth will complete the training that is recommended and offered in regard to the nature of child abuse; and, in regard to carrying out our policies to prevent sexual abuse. Pertinent state law information concerning child abuse reporting obligations will be posted in the church office. Any suspected incident of child and/or sexual abuse will be reported to the authorities.

Safety Is Our Priority

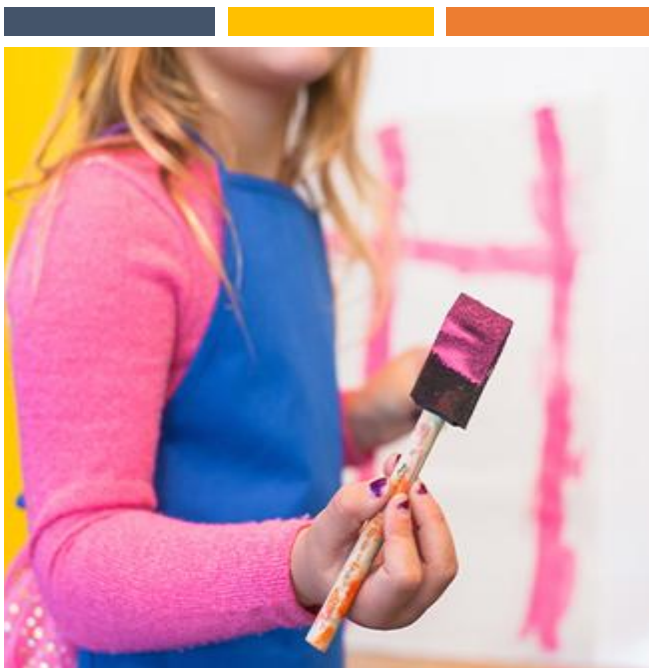
We know and value the importance of the trust you are putting in us when you leave your children in our care. That is why ensuring your child's safety is of utmost importance and carefully considered.

From volunteer and leader screening to security cameras throughout the building and property, making sure that our campus is kept safe allows us to come together as we praise and worship our Heavenly Father.

Check-In & Pick-Up

Making sure that the child is placed in the right classroom as well as released to the correct guardians is crucial for creating a safe environment centered on love. Upon arrival, each family will sign in using our check-in kiosks in the Children's Wing Welcome Area.

Each child will then have a tag with their name, classroom, guardian information, and code created for this specific date and family. Guardians will be given a master tag with the same code present on the child's tag. At pick-up, leaders will match the codes from the child's tag and the master tag. Only adults will be allowed to pick-up children, not older siblings. Unless special accommodations have been made with the Children's Ministry Director.

Security Team

Making sure that the Children's Wing is safe while your child is in our care helps ensure the best possible experience for your entire family. With a trained security team member monitoring cameras placed throughout the building and located close to the entrance doors, we are ready to act in any and every situation.

Fire Drill, Lockdown & CPR Trained

Each member of our volunteer and leader team is trained in our facilities safety procedures ranging from fire drill procedures to building lockdown. Constant communication with the security team member at the entrance of the children's wing along with at least one CPR certified leader present during both the 9:4am and 11:00am services.
