

# KNC FAQ SHEET

2021-2022 Preschool Year



**Masks will be required for which ages?** Masks will be required for all preschoolers ages 2, 3, 4, 5, and 6 year olds. We will require a clean one for each preschool day your child attends. We will have a lot of mask breaks throughout the day and masks will not be worn during snacks, lunch and outside play time. (If you forget your mask or your child's we have extras.)

**What time is preschool?** Preschool is from 9am to 2pm for all classes.

**Where do I drop off my preschooler?** Only one family member will be able to drop off and pick up your preschooler at their preschool room. You will enter from our main entrance and exit the same way. Please remember to social distance and wear your mask. (I know that many of you have had your COVID vaccine, you still need to wear a mask.) **Please remember this will not be a time for conversation with the teacher.** If you

need to talk to your child's teacher please arrange this with the teacher after school.

**Will there be temperature checks?** Your preschooler will have a temperature check each preschool day.

**If I can't linger in my child's classroom how do I know what they are doing?** Your child's teacher will be communicating using the See Saw program. The teachers will be providing you more information related to this program. This will be your window into your child's day. You can ask questions and get feedback with this program. The teachers will also be giving out newsletters and information for your child to take home. Make sure you check your child's backpack for information sheets.

**How do we celebrate birthdays and other special holidays?** We will be having all the celebrations we usually do the only difference is that homemade treats and snacks will not be allowed at this time. Grocery items and bakeries that are certified with commercial kitchens are allowed. Let's celebrate!

**What if I have special instructions for the day?** If you have someone different picking up your preschooler or you have special instructions please let the teacher know on See Saw, or text them. If you do not get a response please call our KNC line at 575-520-6810.

**Will you provide monthly calendars and newsletters?** You will be provided with the calendars for this year and KNC newsletters on our website at [cbclasruces.org/ministries.knc](http://cbclasruces.org/ministries.knc).

**Does the KNC handbook still apply?** Yes, these policies are added handbook policies due to the Covid virus.

**Parent handbook information and added Covid guidelines –**  
when do I leave my preschooler home? On page 10 of the KNC parent handbook is a guide for leaving your preschooler home when ill.

For the Covid virus - If they have 2 of the symptoms on the list following please leave them at home.

**Added Covid List:**

Fever – your child must be fever free for 24 hours before bringing them back to preschool.

If your child has a fever of 100.4 then they will not be permitted to enter the preschool.

You will be asked if you have given any fever reducing medicine within the last 24 hours or if anyone in the home has Covid-19, any variant of Covid or has been in contact with someone who has Covid.

Please remember that if anyone in your home has a covid test and has symptoms of Covid your child may **NOT** come to preschool until you find out the results of that test.

Please remember not to bring your preschooler if they are experiencing any 2 Covid symptoms of the following:

Fever 100.4 or higher

Cough

Shortness of breath or a problem breathing

Chills

Sore throat

Loss of taste or smell

Muscle pain

Runny nose

Diarrhea

Feeling nauseous or vomiting

Feeling tired

Headache

Poor appetite
