

KINDERGARTEN SUPPLY LIST

1. (1) 24 Count Box of Crayola Crayons (no fluorescent or glitter crayons)
2. (1) Pack of Washable Markers (classic or basic colors)
3. * (1) Pair of Blunt Tip Fiskars Metal Scissors (no plastic)
4. * (1) 4 oz Bottle of Elmer's White School Glue (ABSOLUTELY NO ROSS GLUE)
Please be sure your child can open the bottle and squeeze out the glue.
5. * (8) Elmer's JUMBO White Glue Sticks
6. (24) #2 Pencils – sharpened
7. * (1) Blue Folder to carry papers in daily (sturdy with pockets)
8. * School Box (cigar size – no larger than 6" x 9" x 3" and no handles)
*Please be sure your child can open and close it easily. ** NO Pencil Bags*
