

## **KINDERGARTEN SUPPLY LIST**

1. (1) 24 Count Box of Crayola Crayons (no fluorescent or glitter crayons)
2. (1) Pack of Washable Markers (classic or basic colors)
3. \* (1) Pair of Blunt Tip Fiskars Metal Scissors (no plastic)
4. \* (1) 4 oz Bottle of Elmer's White School Glue (ABSOLUTELY NO ROSS GLUE)  
*Please be sure your child can open the bottle and squeeze out the glue.*
5. \* (4) Elmer's JUMBO or (8) Small White Glue Sticks
6. (12) #2 Pencils – sharpened
7. \* (1) Blue Folder to carry papers in daily (sturdy with pockets)
8. \* School Box (cigar size – no larger than 6" x 9" x 3" and no handles)  
*Please be sure your child can open and close it easily. \*\* NO Pencil Bags*
9. \* Backpack (NO WHEELS ALLOWED)  
*Please make sure it is large enough to hold their daily folder.*
