1. (1) 24 Count Box of Crayola Crayons (no fluorescent or glitter crayons)
2. (2) Pack of Washable Markers (classic or basic colors. Fat, not skinny)
3. (2) Black EXPO Markers
4. \* (1) Pair of Blunt Tip Fiskars Metal Scissors (no plastic)
5. \* (1) 4 oz Bottle of Elmer's White School Glue (ABSOLUTELY NO ROSS GLUE)  
*Please be sure your child can open the bottle and squeeze out the glue.*
6. \* (4) Elmer's JUMBO or (8) Small White Glue Sticks
7. (12) #2 Pencils – sharpened
8. \* (1) Blue Folder to carry papers in daily (sturdy with pockets)
