GIVING: In response to the recent message shared by our Pastors and feedback from you, our congregation, we would like to move toward more transparency in our finances specific to giving across both campuses.

As a church, we aim for an undesignated offering of **\$20,000/week** across both campuses to meet our minimum "thriving" expenses. To date, we have been averaging **\$15,876** per week which keeps us in the red.

This past week's offering was an amazing blessing and increase to that average - we received **\$19,521** in undesignated giving. (This includes all in person offerings as well as online giving)

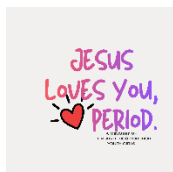

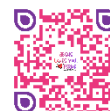

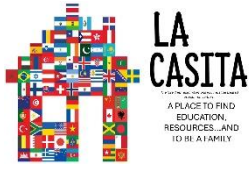
