

Bible Evangelical Free Church 2019 Scholarship Program

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE:

Bible Evangelical Free Church would like to encourage High School Students to continue their education either through college work or technical training by providing them with tuition assistance.

2019 AWARD:

Three (3) \$500.00 scholarships.

Contingent upon funding available and applications submitted, at the discretion of the Scholarship Committee, number of scholarships along with amount of scholarships may be increased.

SCHOOLS:

Christian Colleges, Secular Colleges, and Technical Colleges would be recognized as eligible colleges for scholarships.

ELIGIBILITY:

High School Graduate

Persons returning to school & High School Graduate

Have at least a 2.0 grade point average.

Attend Bible Evangelical Free Church or one of their ministries on a regular basis.

Complete application and include all requested information.

Provide a copy of your high school transcript or college transcript if attending college.

Students may re-apply after receiving a scholarship in subsequent years while continuing their education.

FUNDING:

A scholarship fund would be established by designated gifts/memorials and given through Bible Evangelical Free Church. The Scholarship Fund to be listed on the church offering envelope in the same manner as the Benevolent Fund.
