

## THE YEAR IN REVIEW

## SEPTEMBER 2022 – AUGUST 2023

CAMP BELLEVUE - TABACUNDO, ECUADOR

- 90+ community children served, Monday through Thursday afternoons (mid-September to mid-June) in our After School Program
- > 320+ children and teens served in 4 different camp sessions
- > 1 International Women's Conference hosted
- > 10 short-term mission groups from the USA hosted
- ➤ 8 local groups hosted for conferences, retreats, or special events
- ➤ 600+ people served in medical campaigns in 5 different locations over 2 weeks
- 2 families in the community served with home repairs
- > 1 neighborhood playground renovated
- > 200+ Days for Girls reusable menstrual kits given out to young women in area schools
- ➤ 4 different churches encouraged to serve their communities through projects organized by the camp (VBS programs, medical clinics, etc.)
- 2 different churches served with construction projects
- 3 schools in Ambato served with English lessons
- 2 joint worship services hosted
- > 3 events for youth and/or youth leaders hosted
- > 2 summer interns hosted through the Quito School of Biblical Studies
- 3 AME (Brazilian AIM program) interns completed their 1-year onfield mission experience
- ➤ 6 different teams coached in team dynamics using PATH (Periodic Assessment of Team Health) and/or DISC (Rusty)
- > 3 new coaches trained to use PATH (Rusty)
- > 5 church-planters / evangelists coached throughout the year
- > 25<sup>th</sup> anniversary celebrated with 600 plates of food served!
- > 30+ baptisms through the work of the camp and evangelist partners!
