

## Danli & El Paraíso, Honduras

May God May God bless you brothers and sisters. I hope everyone is well. This first part of the report covers the work of Daniel from November through January.

By the grace of God, we were able to work the entire year in personal evangelism in Danli, as well as in the communities outside of the city. In February, nine persons were baptized.



In October we were able to make some repairs and enhancements to the church property. A special collection in the church provided the resources for us to work on the front façade and repair some damaged infrastructure. We still need to fix the classroom roofs for the children's Sunday school. Rather than use corrugated metal panels, we would like to use cement, but we lack the funds. So we are praying the Lord will provide the necessary funds.

On the spiritual side, we had an evangelistic campaign on Nov. 1-5. We were supported by the students of B.I.C.A., the Bible institute in El Progreso, Yoro. During the week, the students spread out in Danli, as well as in the surrounding communities.

On Tuesday, of that week, we evangelized in El Roblón and Limoncillo. 5 persons were baptized: Francisco Amador, Pastora Amador, Deibeli Álvarez, Génesis Duarte, Helen Peña.

On Wednesday, we evangelized in Linaca and El Paraíso. In Linaca 2 persons were baptized: Iris Zulema, Deilyn Carranza.

On Thursday we evangelized in Santa Ana, Calpules and La Angostura. In Santa Ana 3 persons were baptized: Doris Ardon, Fátima Martínez, and Jaqueline Vanesa Méndez.
