

PREPARING FOR YOUR TRIP TO ISRAEL

Thank you for choosing to be part of the TPT Revival Tour of Israel team. If this is your first tour of Israel then we are honored to introduce you to the Holy Land.

About a month before departure you will receive your Participant Packet with luggage tags, a name tag, packing tips, and many more details. In the meantime, here are few important ways for you to prepare for the tour.

Spiritual preparation

The most important thing is to be spiritually prepared for your trip.

- **Read the Bible.** We recommend that you read The Gospels, Genesis, and the historical books of Judges, Samuel, Chronicles and Kings. You will be personally visiting many of the places where Jesus ministered and where some of the most famous stories of the Old Testament took place.
- **Pray.** Being in Israel with believers from around the world is a very special experience. Having your heart and mind in the right place will greatly enhance your experience. Not only should you expect encounters with our Lord, but you should be prepared to be flexible and be excited to meet and show love to the many other people that you will meet on this trip.

Physical Preparation

The tour will include a lot of walking and climbing of stairs. If you are not involved in regular exercise, we recommend that you start a new habit! Your exercise routine should, at a minimum, include walking and stair climbing.

Make necessary transportation arrangements

Land Only Package. If you selected the Land Only Package then you are responsible for booking your own airfare and meeting the team in Israel. Please see the *Booking Your Own Airfare* document included in your confirmation email.

Full Tour Package. If you selected the Full Tour Package, you are responsible for making your own arrangements to get to and from JFK to meet the team for the group flight.

Make sure your PASSPORT is up to date.

Israel requires that your passport expire at least 6 months after your travel dates. This means that your passport should expire after April 30th, 2019. If not, renew it now!

Start saving so you can make your tour payments

Your second payment is due April 30th, 2018 and your final balance is due July 31, 2018. It is very important that you make your payments on time as we are required to make final payments to secure hotels, buses, guides, etc. If you payments are not made on time, we cannot guarantee your spot on the tour.
