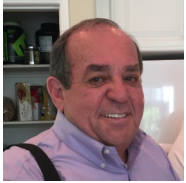

## From Our Messianic Leader.....



### HOW TO HANDLE DIFFICULT SITUATIONS

Saul, or the apostle Paul, while he was a prisoner in Rome, wrote a letter to the church of the Philip-pines. Although he was confined and under careful watch while he was waiting for his trial, he wrote the Philip-pines to encourage them. He basically told them that his situa-tion was being used by Adonai. In Phil. 4:11 he told them *"I am not saying this because I am in need—for whatever circum-stance I am in, I have learned to be content."* As we study this verse closely, Paul did not say that he was always happy. Happiness really depends on the circumstances, but as believers contentment can be possible in any situation if it is anchored in Adonai our Almighty Father. Although Paul, being in prison, was undoubtedly uncom-fortable, he scarcely mentions the conditions. His letter was **Not Filled** with complaints, but with rejoicing because his total focus was on his Messiah. *Phil.1;20-21* *"My eager expectation and hope is that in no way will I be put to shame, but that with complete boldness Messiah will even now, as always, be exalted in my body—whether through life or through death. For to me, to live is Messiah and to die is gain."*

Paul didn't see himself as a victim.

He believed and knew he was un-der the sovereign hand of the Al-mighty. This place was ordained for him in accordance with Ado-nai's divine purpose for him.

In addition, he saw good results in his time in prison. The entire imperial guard heard about Ye-shua through Paul's consistent witness. His imprisonment also had an opposite effect of what his enemies had planned for him. In-stead of driving the Christians into hiding, his example of conten-tment in the face of the hard situa-tions made them bolder. *Phil 1:14* *"Because of my imprison-ment, most of the brothers and sisters have become confident in the Lord to dare more than ever to speak the message fearlessly."*

Like Paul, we can choose how to respond to pain and/or hardship. If we opt to be resentful and bit-ter, the suffering will be wasted. But if we see each situation as a wonderful opportunity for spiritual growth, we'll be able to learn con-tentment and rejoice in the Lord though it all. I don't say it's going to be easy, but *1 Thessalonians 5:16-18 TLV* tell us: *"Rejoice al-ways, pray constantly, in eve-rything give thanks; for this is God's will for you in Messi-ah Yeshua."*

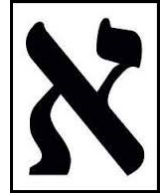
