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




## DETAILS



PLEASE PACK A LUNCH FOR MONDAY.


### **For the City: Linton Dress Code**

Bikinis, Speedo






# GREAT EXPECTATIONS

## Century Baptist Student Ministry

Because we want our time together to be a mile marker moment for you and your peers in your walk with Jesus, we want you to understand the role you are playing during the week of FOR THE CITY: LINTON. Before you sign on the dotted line, we want you to carefully and prayerfully look over the following expectations of our time together, not only during this experience but at any time we are together as a Middle School Ministry family.

1. We-your youth leaders-LOVE YOU! We want God's best for you. Trust us in that! Because God's Word tells us to respect and honor authority, we ask that you respect, listen to, and cooperate with the youth leaders, adult leaders, and drivers at all times.
  2. Be each other's biggest fan. A disciple of Jesus actively follows Him and loves people. We have to do our job of loving each other really well and being for each other. We do this because Scripture calls us to love each other, to build each other up, and encourage each other to run after Jesus. Anything that doesn't fall under those three categories will not be tolerated.
  3. Shine the Light. A disciple of Jesus imitates Him at all times and focuses their everyday life on becoming more like Him. We may be the only example someone sees of Jesus in their lifetime, so let's make sure we leave our mark in a way that glorifies Jesus. This means that we need to respect whatever facility we find ourselves in at anytime, along with the people serving us. We act in a way that Jesus would act and speak in a way He would speak. Actions or words that point someone away from Jesus will be confronted by the Middle School Director and/or a youth leader.
  4. If you're going to be here, then be here. Without a doubt, we know Jesus is going to show up in big ways. If we're not present in the moment, we may miss what Jesus has in store for us. There will be times when you'll be asked to put away your electronic devices, and that's because we don't want you to miss out on what Jesus has for you. There will be times of fun and chaos, but there will also be times to be quiet and be still. Do your best to be here in each of those moments. If we (your youth leaders) remind of this, remember it's because we love you and want God's best for you.
