Training Guidelines & Prayer Focus

1. Punctuality and Preparation

Guideline: Arrive early for all services, ready for pre-service prayer and spiritual preparation.

2. Approach Prayer with Spiritual

Focus and Fervency

Guideline: Engage the presence of God with fervent prayer (tongues), ready to intercede for the service and those who will attend.

Prayer Focus: Pray with intensity of the God's presence, asking for hearts to be open to salvation, healing, and transformation.

3. Pray for the Harvest and Spiritual Breakthroughs

Focus Area: Pray that the services are filled with people who are ready to be set free by the Father's anointing.

4. Activate the Gifts of the Spirit

Guideline: Pray for a strong flow of spiritual gifts, such as prophecy, healing, and discernment, to manifest in our services.

Prayer Focus: Ask the Holy Spirit to empower all leaders and members, making them sensitive to His guidance and ready to be vessels for miracles, signs, and wonders.

5. Pray for Leaders and Ministers

Focus Area: Pray for boldness and a door of utterance for Apostle McKinley Hardy, Dr. Cindy Hardy, and all the five-fold ministry leaders.

6. Foster a Spirit of Unity and Purpose

Guideline: Pray for unity among the leadership and the entire congregation, that there would be no division or discord in the family so every joint can supply.

7. Prepare for Service with an Attentive and Prayerful Mindset

Guideline: Keep an attitude of continuous prayer before and during service. Be attentive to what God is doing and ready to respond.

8. Pray that every member of OAC is harvest minded, reaching the lost and discipling the youth.

9. **Pray that our Children's Church workers** are anointed to uniquely minister to our children, and our children are powerhouses for the Father, doing mighty exploits by declaring the Name.
10. **Pray that the Ministry of Helps & Hospitality** serves with gladness, and they are sharp, alert, anointed, and strengthened in their inner man for each service.
11. **Pray that OAC is a tithing and giving church** that stewards what the Father gives and has a heart for the community.
12. **Pray for the members of OAC and their families** and that every need in their lives and homes are met.
13. **Pray for the spirit of unity and oneness among the five-fold leadership staff** at OAC and that there be no division or discord.
14. **Pray that the Body of Christ is sensitive to the move of the Holy Spirit** and move within Him.
15. **Pray that the members will catch the vision and heart that the Father has given for Omni Abba Church and Apostle Hardy & Dr. Hardy.**

Prior to and during service:

- Keep an attitude of prayer.
- Be ready and sensitive to the Spirit for any situation.
- Watch the overall scheme of the operation and flow of the service.
- Be attentive to the staff and what they say.
- Work together in unity and do everything in love.
- Make sure the person you bring in the ministry room is reading the same version as you, to stay on one accord, so there will be no confusion.

1. Salvation

Definition: meaning you have not been born again because you never received Jesus Christ as your Lord and Savior

The Need: Romans 5:12 (Let the person read)

"Therefore, just as through one man sin entered the world, and death through sin, and thus death spread to all men, because all sinned." (NKJV)

The "one man" mentioned here is Adam. His disobedience caused everyone born after him to inherit sin, like a family curse. We are all born into sin. So our Father is not looking at our sins because it was not our fault if we inherited it from Adam.

Real-World Example: Imagine someone drowning in the ocean, desperate for help. A rescue boat arrives, offering a lifeline, but the person must choose to grab hold of it. Similarly, our brother Jesus offers us salvation, but we must choose to accept His gift.

The Solution: John 3:16 (Read)

"For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life." (NKJV)

Personalize this verse: Your Father's love extends to you individually, and through belief in Christ, you receive eternal life.

- Jesus died on the cross as a sacrifice to reconcile us back to our heavenly father, for an eternal relationship
- So, when we accept the finish work of the cross we are accepting the redemption that the ransom paid for us to being born again into Abba's family as His child.
- As His children we have a predestined purpose, inheritance, and kingdom responsibility.

The Name of the Solution: Acts 4:12 (Read)

"Nor is there salvation in any other, for there is no other name under heaven given among men by which we must be saved." (NKJV)

There is no other Name under heaven given, whereby we must be saved. It is not in Apostle Peters name, Elijah Mohammad's name, or Buddha's name. It's not in the ancestor's name, your mother's name or even your natural father's name. It is the matchless name of Jesus that saves you (His finished works) because he was the sacrifice and ransom that brings us back to what Adam lost, which is the relationship with our Heavenly Father.

How to Apply the Solution: Romans 10:8-10 (Let the person read)

"But what does it say? 'The word is near you, in your mouth and in your heart' (that is, the word of faith which we preach): that if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. For with the heart one believes unto righteousness, and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation." (NKJV)

When the Bible talks about the word “heart,” it’s not speaking of the organ that pumps blood through your body, but rather your inner most being. The word, “confess” means “to say.” You must open your mouth to confess, and you must believe that His finished works, will make you a new creation; to give you a brand new start.

The born-again experience means you are saved/rescued translated from one kingdom to another (darkness to light). The word “salvation” comes from the Greek word “*soteria*,” and it means soundness, safety, healing, preservation, and deliverance. Amen! It’s what I call the Kingdom Benefit Package. Your eternal life begins now!

The Gift: Ephesians 2:8-9 (Let the person read)

"For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God, not of works, lest anyone should boast." (NKJV)

Salvation is a gift. You can't work for it, sing for it, not can you do anything else to get it. You must simply receive it by faith. The Father gives. You receive. It's like playing checkers. You must know when it is your turn to move; and it's your turn to move.

The Right to Receive this Gift/New Birth: John 1:12 (Let them read)

"But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, to those who believe in His name." (NKJV)

You have a right to receive salvation. The word right is also the word power, authority, or privilege. Your Father gives you the right and

authority to become a child of God, adopted into His family, making us coheirs of the promise.

ARE YOU READY? (Have them repeat the prayer below) And once your done don't forget to rejoice and welcome them into the family of God; be excited for them because a soul was won for the Kingdom.

The Prayer:

Father, I recognize that I have not lived my life for You up until now. I need You and want You in my life. I acknowledge the finish works of Your Son Jesus Christ on the cross, and I receive the forgiveness You have made freely available to me. Come into my life, Lord. Be my King, my Lord, and my Savior. Reconcile me back to my Father.

Amen!

2. Rededication

Definition: meaning that you are a child of God, but sin has caused your fellowship to be broken and you want to get back in fellowship with your heavenly Father today.

Rededication: I John 1:9 (Read)

"If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness." (NKJV)

Real-World Example: Think of a married couple who have grown apart but are still married. Rededication is like renewing wedding vows, restoring their closeness.

I want you to know that you never broke your relationship with the Father. You just got out of fellowship with Him.

The Bible says, in 1 John 1:9, "If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

As I pray for you, I want you to confess under your breath whatever you believe caused your fellowship to be broken and ask your Father to forgive you. Remember to give thanks to the Father for a change of attitude so that your heart can return to what is most important.

*Allow a few seconds or minutes for the alter call respondent/corporately or person your ministering to, to confess and then pray the rededication prayer below and have them repeat this after you:

Father, I humble myself before you. I want to thank you for listening to my prayer. I see where I've been going the wrong way and I've been placing my faith and trust in everyone and everything but you.

Father, I return now to you, the Body, my destiny, and your Word. I pray for guidance as I listen for your voice. Let me return to what is most important; you. Help my attitude to change so that instead of focusing on others and events to meet my needs met, I can turn to you and find the love, purpose, and direction I seek. Help me to seek your kingdom first and your righteousness. Let my relationship with you be the most important thing in my life.

Thank you, Father, for helping me, loving me, and showing me the way. Thank you for new mercies, for forgiving me. I rededicate myself to you wholly. I surrender my will to your will. I give you back control of my life. Lead me by your Spirit.

You are the only one who gives freely, with love to anyone who asks, and I know that you have heard my prayer and I am restored back in fellowship with the Family of God.

Amen!

Individual Rededication Prayer:

- When praying with a person individually for rededication make sure you ask the person what their prayer needs are and pray according to the person's personal needs and by the Spirit.

Example: Father (*name of the person*) comes to you to rededicate their life to you. We thank you Father that you are always there with open arms to receive you children back. Help (*name of person*) to find their destiny and purpose in you and to stop doing things according to their own will or how they see things. Open the eyes of their heart Holy Spirit so that they may see what you have created them for. I pray for strength and guidance for (*name of the person*) as a beloved child of Abba. Amen!

3. Membership

Definition: meaning you want to be a part of the Omni Abba Family and Apostle McKinley Hardy and Dr. Cindy Hardy, will be your spiritual leaders.

- Children only grow up correctly in families
- Children with no families are considered orphans.
- Children need parents and siblings to grow and sharpen their spiritual life.

The **Corporate Membership Prayer** is for new members that are invited to stand before the congregation/family of God, and a brief, informal introduction can be given by the minister/leader.

[Addressing the New Members:]

In your baptism, you were marked as members of Christ's Church. It is our joy to welcome you today as members of this family. We believe that the Holy Spirit has led you to this family at this time for your own good and the good of this family, He has placed you in. We invite you now to affirm your faith in Christ and express your commitment to the life of this church and vision the Father has given to us.

Corporate Membership Prayer:

- **For Spiritual Maturity:** Father, I pray that those who has just recently placed his/her faith in you will grow to spiritual maturity, attaining to the whole measure of the fullness of Christ. May he/she speak the truth in love so that he/she will in all things grow up into Christ. (Ephesians 4:13-15).
- **For Humility to allow others to teach and train:** Father, may these new believers open their hearts to those who are more

mature in faith so that their love may abound more and more in knowledge and depth of insight, so that they may be able to discern what is best and may be pure and blameless until the day of Christ, filled with the fruit of righteousness that comes through Jesus Christ—to the glory and praise of the Father (Phil. 1:9-11).

- **Pray** that they, being filled with the Holy Spirit, will discover and utilize the gifts the Father has given and use them to the best of their ability in serving others.
- **Pray** that they will have a daily, disciplined quiet time to know the Word of God and develop a powerful life of prayer. So, that their ears may hear the voice of their Father.
- **Pray** that they will be able to resist the enemy and overcome sin/challenges when it arises in their lives.
- **Pray** that they will develop a fruitful ministry for advancing the kingdom in their church, community and beyond through the power of the Holy Spirit.
- **Pray** that they will be bold in their witness to unbelievers, having courage to share their testimony

- **Have all the new members fill out a membership connection card.**

Reminders

- Make sure the visitor leaves with church information
- Make sure the visitor has connected with Hospitality to fill out the visitor Connect Card on the OAC churchtrac app
- Remind the visitor that their spiritual life is a journey that the Father has to be apart of for them to operate in their purpose, so it is important that they continue to show up for Sunday and Thursday services to help them conform to Christ.

4. The Baptism in the Holy Spirit w/ the Evidence of Speaking in Tongues

Definition: meaning that you have been born again and you want to receive the Baptism of the Holy Spirit with the Bible evidence of speaking in other tongues/heavenly prayer language.

Holy Spirit: the sacred and life-giving breath or Spirit of God, emphasizing God's active, sanctifying presence and power. It is understood as the very Spirit of God our Father, not a separate person but God's own divine presence and active power, bringing life and holiness and equipping sons and daughters of God.

Repeat after me..." I will receive, the baptism of the Holy Spirit, with the evidence of speaking with other tongues. In Jesus Name!!"

The Gift: Acts 2:38 (Have the person read)

"Then Peter said to them, 'Repent, and let every one of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins; and you shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.'" **(NKJV)**

You don't work for a gift you just receive it. No matter what condition or place in your life you may feel like your in.

The Promise: John 14:16-17 (Have the person read)

"And I will pray the Father, and He will give you another Helper, that He may abide with you forever—the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees Him nor knows Him; but you know Him, for He dwells with you and will be in you." (NKJV)

The Holy Spirit is from God the Father (a promise that was giving). Jesus proves this by saying, "And I will pray the Father and He shall give you another comforter..." and the Father did just that.

[The Power](#) (what is it for and why do I need it): Acts 1:8 (Have the person read)

"But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth." (NKJV)

The word "power" (Greek: *dunamis*) means dynamic, explosive ability.

The word, "power," is translated "*dunamis*" and it means strength, ability, or power often associated with miraculous or supernatural force and abilities. This power is to live a transformed life, perform supernatural works, and be a bold witness for Christ. Power helps you do what you cannot do in your own strength.

[How to Receive](#): (what must I do to receive): Luke 11:9-13 (Have the person read)

"So I say to you, ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you. For everyone who asks receives, and he who seeks finds, and to him who knocks it will be opened. If a son asks for bread from any father among you, will he give him a stone? Or if he asks for a fish, will he give him a serpent instead of a fish? Or if he asks for an egg, will he offer him a scorpion? If you then, being evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to those who ask Him!" (NKJV)

No one who is a good parent will give their hungry or thirsty children anything other than something to eat, or drink, when asked. If it's in their power to do so, they won't just give them anything to eat or drink, but they will give them exactly what they ask for. Neither will your heavenly father give you anything other than the Holy Spirit when you ask him. Ask and it shall be given. If you asked for the Holy Spirit to be upon you today, you shall receive exactly what you asked for.

A Person is Filled Then They Speak: (stress this point): Acts 10:44-46 (Have the person read)

When someone receives the Holy Spirit, they are empowered to speak in tongues or manifest other spiritual expressions as a result of being filled. This is not a mechanical action but a response to the infilling of the Spirit of God.

"And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance." (NKJV)

- In this verse, the disciples were filled with the Holy Spirit and immediately began speaking in other tongues as the Spirit enabled them. The act of speaking was the outward manifestation of their inward filling.

How do You Know What You Are Saying? (I'm glad you asked that): I Corinthians 14:2 (Have the person read)

"For he who speaks in a tongue does not speak to men but to God, for no one understands him; however, in the spirit he speaks mysteries." (NKJV)

Speaking in tongues means communicating directly with God who is your Father. Don't try to understand what you are saying. Just open your mouth and start to speak.

Repeat after me... "Today I will receive, the baptism of the Spirit with the evidence, of speaking with other tongues. In Jesus Name!!"

Baptism & Speaking in Tongues Prayer:

Now Stand Up...Repeat after me...

Father, your word says that the Holy Spirit is a gift. I don't work for Him: all I do is receive Him. So, Father, I receive right now, as an act of my will and my faith, the Holy Spirit, with the manifestation of other tongues.

I will not be embarrassed. I will not shake my head no! I won't try to understand it with my natural mind. But I will speak with other tongues on the count of three.

Are you ready? (Say yes) are you ready? All right let's count....1-2-3, Take a deep breath in, and as you exhale you shall speak...

(*At this point the person should be speaking in tongues. If they are not, explain to them: "this might sound like a baby talking, it may feel like water in your stomach, a burning sensation, or like fire. Don't worry about the way that it makes you feel or how you sound. Just say it whatever you hear.)

Now this is when you can go over a list of benefits that speaking in tongues do (Just go over a few to encourage the person to do it in their person time) Please see Appendix I, which is a list of 100 Benefits/reasons of someone should pray in tongues (give the person a few of those reasons as you close the session out) Leave them build up in their most holy faith and something in their hand!

APPENDIX 1

Omni Abba Church Declaration Prayer:
