General Responsibilities

The A/V Intern for Children's and Student Ministry will be responsible for attending all gatherings and events, leading and coordinating summer activities that will foster relationships and community, facilitate spiritual growth in children and students and the families they represent all while using technology, film, recording, to enhance our ministries.

Specific Responsibilities

- Execute and complete in depth video projects (such as: VBS, summer camp, mission trip, summer recap videos)
- Assist with tech aspects of summer programming and special events
- Attend and act as a key leader on all trips and events
- Assist in fostering an environment where students come to "hang out"
- Develop Christ-centered relationships with students and children
- Work with Children and Student Ministry Directors
- Attend and participate in Team Meetings and (and staff meetings when necessary)
- Have the opportunity to learn day to day tasks of Children's and Student ministry such as budgeting, pre-planning and organization of events and trips
- Complete their ONE BIG THING (see below)

Characteristics

- Candidate needs to be grounded in their faith and be comfortable leading discussions, sharing experiences, and talking to students about Jesus.
- Candidate **must** be a self-starter and must be motivated.
- Candidate must be responsible and trustworthy
- Candidates must come with some amount of proficiency with A/V equipment.

Hours

- Sundays 4-8pm
- Monday - Thursday: 10 hours
- Retreats and Events: typically fall outside of regular weekly hours and attendance is required for interns

Pay

- \$2500 for the summer (begins at the end of May-end of July)
- Paid every two weeks
