# **Exciting work with fellow missionary - Guyana**



What a pleasure it is to work with like-minded missionaries. In May, Missionary Gregg Mann invited Russ to speak at his pastor's conference in Guyana. They had a great meeting with the pastors and an uplifting service on Sunday. This is a unique work in that the church is close to the river, and the people come to church by boat (boat-taxi).



After concluding the pastor's conference, Russ and Pastor Gregg drove closer to the Venezuelan border,



to an Indigenous village of the Warao Tribe. These people speak Spanish as well as their Indian dialect. They understand very little English (the Guyanese language) so evangelism efforts with these people has been slower. Russ had the privilege of preaching to them in Spanish. Many people were saved, and on the last day Russ baptized 24 people. This is a new work in development for the glory of the Lord.

Two weeks later following the Guyana conference, Russ left for Colombia and his next adventure – a new area for him. The hand of God was with him every moment...
