### "Dining with Dignity"

Many of you are familiar with and participate in our church's vital food ministries. The food bank and Tuesday breakfasts are key parts of the ministry work of our church. We also support Shalom Ministries in their work feeding and assisting Spokane's downtowncitizens in need,

Shalom Ministries was established in 1994 as a ministry of Central United Methodist Church in downtown Spokane. Though that church is now closed Shalom continues with the support of many churches, including Audubon Park.

Shalom provides hot nutritious meals to downtown Spokane's poor and houseless, serving 6 breakfasts and 2 dinners each week. We also partner with 10 other agencies to offer pathways to physical and mental health services, addiction support and housing placement. To learn more about Shalom Ministries go to shalommeal.org.

As the need has grown in our community Shalom's budget requirements have increased as well. We anticipate we will serve 80,000 meals in 2025. These growing needs have made the success of our major fundraising event, the annual Dining With Dignity Gala, more crucial than ever.






Floral Sketchbook Grow Class with Lisa Lishner

Thursdays at 10:00 AM beginning September 11 (at the Church)



### YOUTH INTERN:


We're planning to hire a youth intern! Let Drew know you know a college student who would love to connect with students and help with youth activities.


### 3rd (& 4th) Grade Bibles!

Earlier this summer we cancelled our contract with our previous giving software vendor, Vanco, and asked everyone to transfer to our new giving software, called Subsplash. We made this change to save the church money in service fees. We know that not everyone who had set up automated giving with Vanco made the transition.

So we're asking you to please take a look at the giving statement you'll receive soon to make sure it reflects your commitment and intention for 2025.

If you're behind in your giving for this year, we encourage you to catch up if you can. But if you're facing financial hardship or otherwise cannot, we very much understand.

We'll send statements out again in January as usual for you to use for your taxes.
