

Search Committee – January 2, 2022, First Sunday of the Month Update

We have made our first cut of those applicants that we are no longer pursuing and determined those that we want to continue and invite to schedule a Zoom conference call. We have scheduled Zoom interviews with the remaining candidates which we hope to be concluded by mid to late January 2022. The committee will then again discern and invite the finalist candidates to any in person interview at Trinity.

Barring any Covid restrictions or any other unforeseen occurrences, we hope to schedule the in-person interviews for mid to late February. As you may recall, all finalists will have an extensive background check done by the Diocese and meet with our Bishop, the Rt. Rev. Alan M. Gates during this stage. Additionally, the Finance Committee has conveyed that after reviewing the results of the 2022 Stewardship Campaign and a review of the current Parish financials that Trinity is in a solid financial position to call a ¾ time Rector.

So, as we are currently engaged in a very interactive and exciting part of our journey, please remember that the Holy Spirit is guiding us and has brought us to this point and will continue until a rector is chosen. We can also report that the Search Committee continues to be very pleased with our progress.
