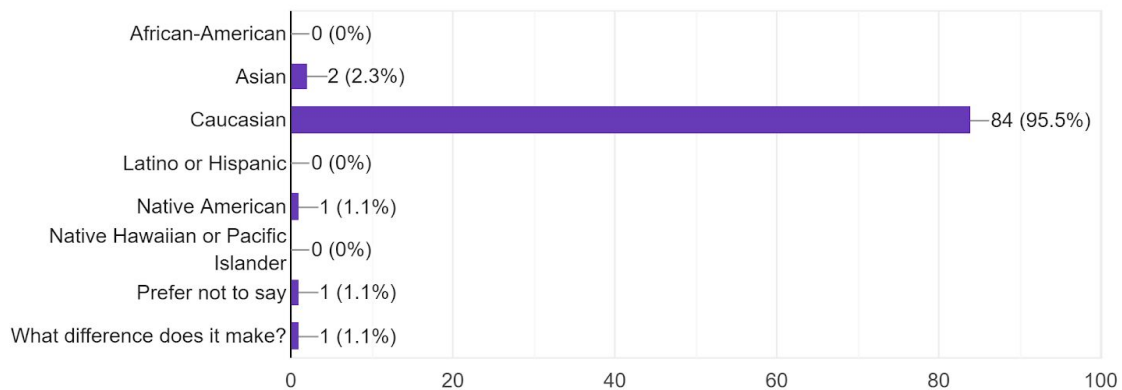

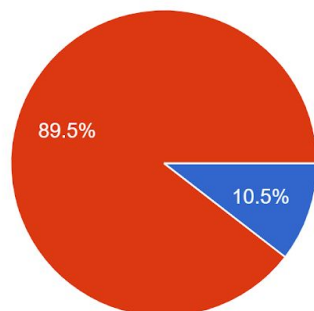

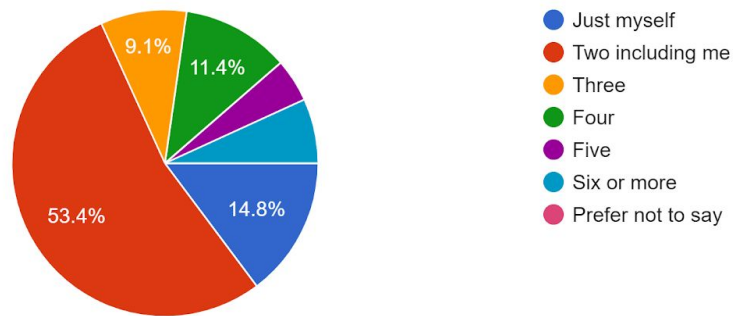

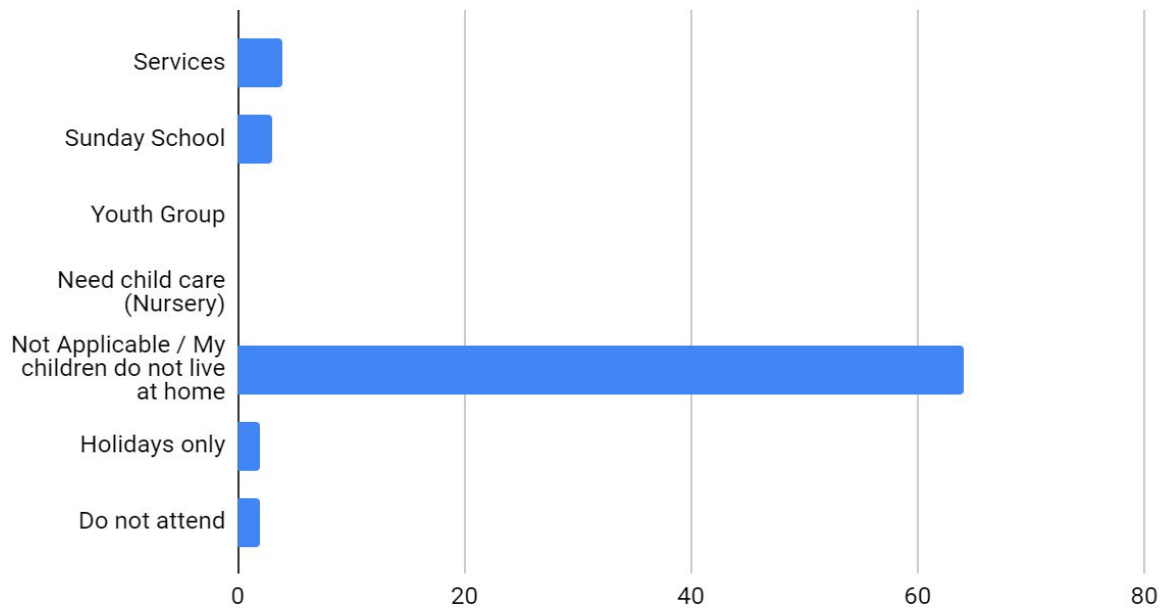

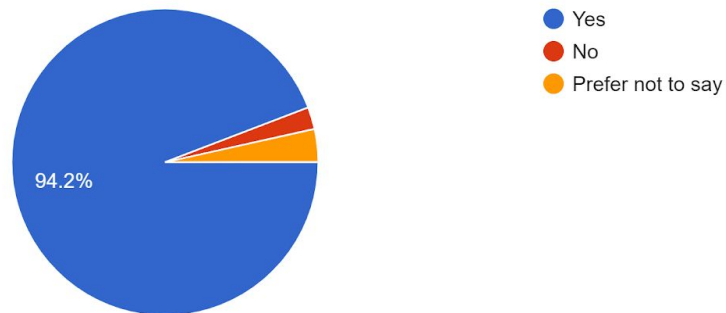


At Trinity, my children regularly participate in



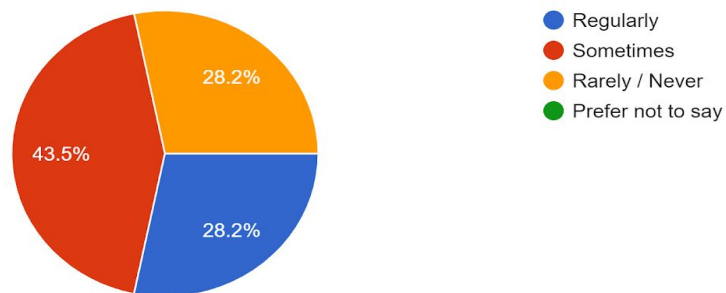

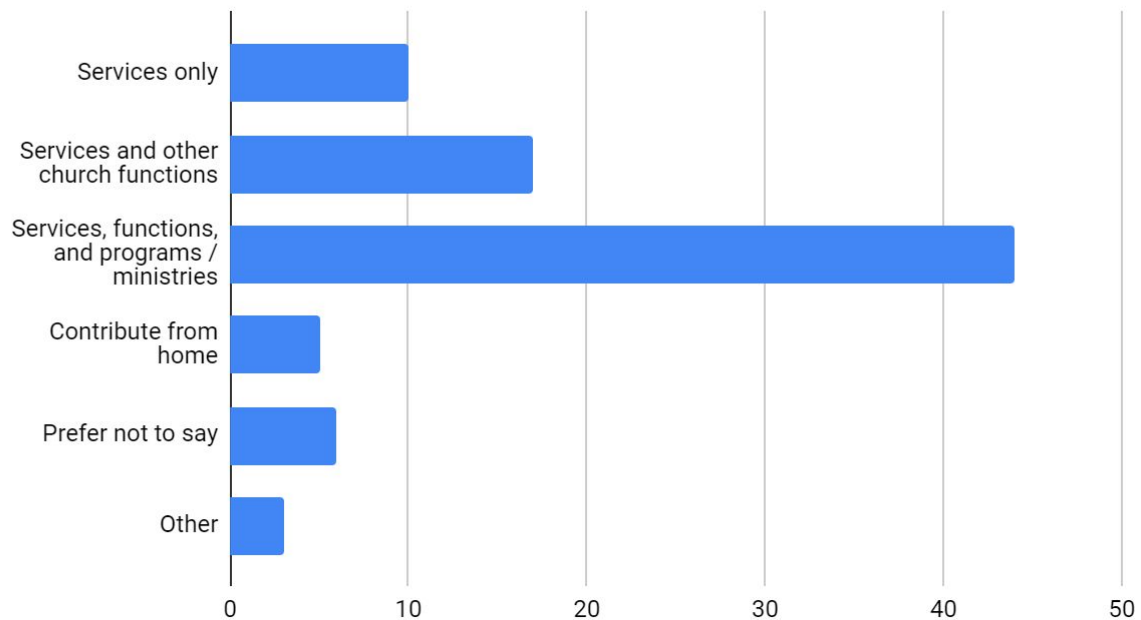

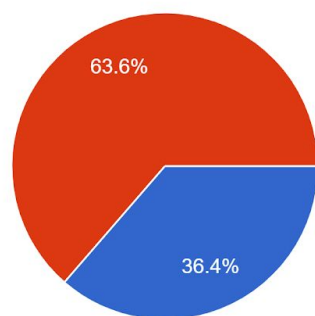

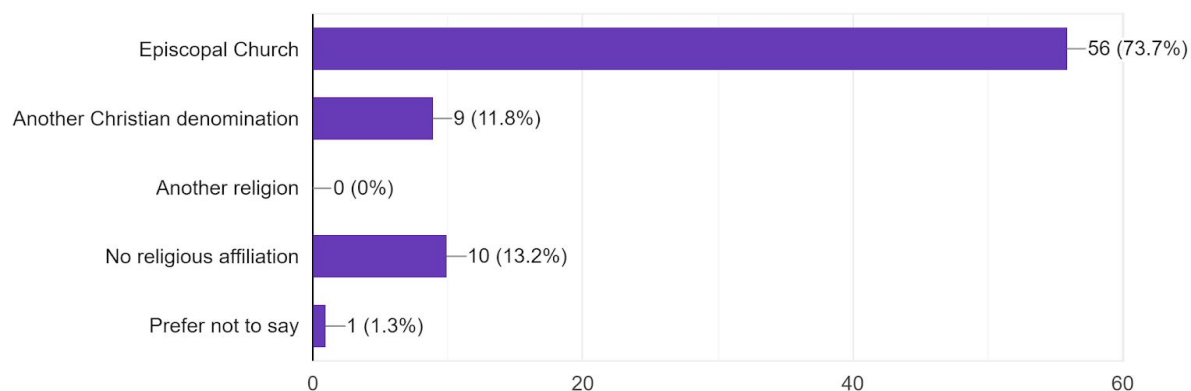

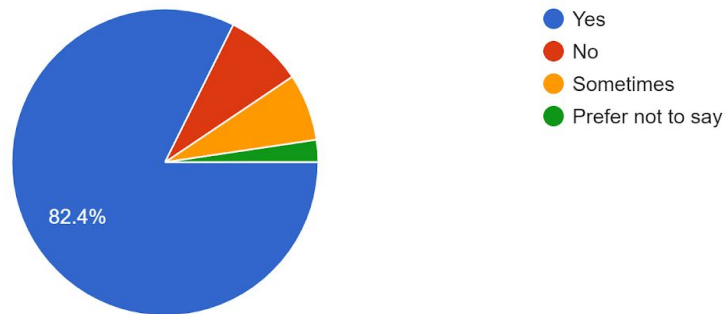
