

As We Gather

"Advent" means "coming." In this first service for Our Dear Christ Enters In special series for Advent, we consider the uniqueness of the family tree that Jesus was born into, and we contemplate how blessed we are to be a part of the family tree of God because of Christ.

THE CONFESSION OF SINS AND ASSURANCE OF FORGIVENESS (from Psalm 32)

Blessed is he whose transgression is forgiven,

whose sins are covered.

Blessed is the man against whom sin the Lord counts no iniquity against him **and in whose spirit there is no deceit.**

I acknowledged my sin to you,

and I did not cover up my iniquity;

I said, "I will confess my transgressions to the Lord"—

and you forgave the iniquity of my sin.

Let us confess our sins to God and ask His forgiveness.

(Please kneel)

King Jesus,

we confess that we so often give you lip service with our tongues yet deny you with our thoughts, words and actions. We have not placed you first in every area of our lives, nor have we considered all others as better than ourselves. Hear us as we take this moment to confess our sins, especially those sins that are weighing heavily on our consciences right now:

(Silence for personal confession.)

"'Comfort, comfort my people,' says your God. 'Speak tenderly to Jerusalem and cry to her that her iniquity is pardoned'" (Isaiah 40:1-2). In his tender mercy, God has given his Son to die for you and for his sake forgives you all your sins. Therefore, upon this your confession, I announce the grace of God to you. In his stead and by his command, I forgive you all your sins in the name of the Father and of the + Son and of the Holy Spirit.

LIGHTING OF THE ADVENT WREATH: THE HOPE CANDLE

Today, we light the first candle on the Advent wreath. God is our hope. He fulfilled His promises from old to give his Son, Jesus Christ. Jesus is the hope of the nations. Every good and perfect gift is from heaven above,

Coming down from the Father of lights.

We gather to celebrate the good and perfect gift of hope

As we wait eagerly for our adoption as children, the redemption of our bodies.

For in this hope we are saved

And in His name we put our hope.

His name is—

Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace—

Immanuel, Sun of Righteousness, the Desire of Nations, the Lion of the tribe of Judah.

Yet the name that is above every name is—

Jesus.

In His name we put our hope! Amen.

Jesus, through your sacrifice, you have brought us forgiveness and peace.

We are your own in Jesus, and we are grateful.

THE OLD TESTAMENT READING: Genesis 15:1-6 (The Lord's Covenant With Abram.)

¹ After these things the word of the LORD came to Abram in a vision: "Fear not, Abram, I am your shield; your reward shall be very great." ² But Abram said, "O Lord GOD, what will you give me, for I continue childless, and the heir of my house is Eliezer of Damascus?" ³ And Abram said, "Behold, you have given me no offspring, and a member of my household will be my heir." ⁴ And behold, the word of the LORD came to him: "This man shall not be your heir; your very own son shall be your heir." ⁵ And he brought him outside and said, "Look toward heaven, and number the stars, if you are able to number them." Then he said to him, "So shall your offspring be." ⁶ And he believed the LORD, and he counted it to him as righteousness.


THE EPISTLE READING: Romans 1:1-6 (Paul was called to preach the Gospel.)

This is the Word of the Lord.



THE HOLY GOSPEL IS ANNOUNCED:

The Holy Gospel according to St. Mark the ninth chapter.



THE HOLY GOSPEL: Matthew 1:1-17 (The Genealogy of our Lord, Jesus Christ.)

- ¹ The book of the genealogy of Jesus Christ, the son of David, the son of Abraham.
- ² Abraham was the father of Isaac, and Isaac the father of Jacob, and Jacob the father of Judah and his brothers, ³ and Judah the father of Perez and Zerah by Tamar, and Perez the father of Hezron, and Hezron the father of Ram, ⁴ and Ram the father of Amminadab, and Amminadab the father of Nahshon, and Nahshon the father of Salmon, ⁵ and Salmon the father of Boaz by Rahab, and Boaz the father of Obed by Ruth, and Obed the father of Jesse, ⁶ and Jesse the father of David the king.
- ⁷ and Solomon the father of Rehoboam, and Rehoboam the father of Abijah, and Abijah the father of Asaph, ⁸ and Asaph the father of Jehoshaphat, and Jehoshaphat the father of Joram, and Joram the father of Uzziah, ⁹ and Uzziah the father of Jotham, and Jotham the father of Ahaz, and Ahaz the father of Hezekiah, ¹⁰ and Hezekiah the father of Manasseh, and Manasseh the father of Amos, and Amos the father of Josiah, ¹¹ and Josiah the father of Jechoniah and his brothers, at the time of the deportation to Babylon.

¹² And after the deportation to Babylon: Jechoniah was the father of Shealtiel, and Shealtiel the father of Zerubbabel, ¹³ and Zerubbabel the father of Abiud, and Abiud the father of Eliakim, and Eliakim the father of Azor, ¹⁴ and Azor the father of Zadok, and Zadok the father of Achim, and Achim the father of Eliud, ¹⁵ and Eliud the father of Eleazar, and Eleazar the father of Matthan, and Matthan the father of Jacob, ¹⁶ and Jacob the father of Joseph the husband of Mary, of whom Jesus was born, who is called Christ. ¹⁷ So all the generations from Abraham to David were fourteen generations, and from David to the deportation to Babylon fourteen generations, and from the deportation to Babylon to the Christ fourteen generations.

This is the Gospel of the Lord.


