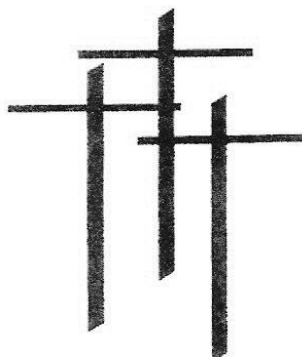


2019 Lenten Luncheon Series:
