Where am I slowing down? How am I steering my life—and my family—toward God each day?

Not just on Christmas Eve, but all through December... in the mornings, around the dinner table, in quiet moments, and even in the hurried ones.

Your 2026 Pledge Card: A Gift of Faithfulness

Thank you to everyone who has already turned in a pledge card for 2026. If you haven't yet, now is a great time. Your commitment helps us prepare faithfully for the ministry God is calling us to in the coming year. Scripture gives us this bold promise:

When we bring the full tithe, God opens the windows of heaven and pours out blessing.

It's not pressure—it's invitation. A call to trust God with the very thing that often tightens our hearts the most.

But hear this: **giving is not "all or nothing."** If you feel like you cannot tithe yet, or you simply aren't ready—don't freeze, and don't pick a random amount just to check the box.

Pick a percentage. A percentage ties our giving to the Giver.

Dollar amounts make us feel good about what we've done. Percentages remind us that everything we have comes from God. Choose a percentage and grow toward a tithe.

Or... if you're feeling brave... maybe God is nudging you toward 11%.

Generosity grows us. It frees us. It opens our hearts to God's blessings in ways nothing else can.

This year's Advent worship will help us quiet our spirits, center our hearts, and wait on Jesus with expectation. I hope you'll make weekly worship a priority—not just for your soul, but for the spiritual formation of your family. We need this.

Half of our offering will go straight to those in need here in Perry and Houston County—families and individuals who need food, shelter, assistance, and hope.


Christmas Eve is a beautiful time to make a difference.


This Advent, may we wait with hope, give with joy, worship with intention, and celebrate the Savior who has come and is coming again.


