

Prayer Guide for the Honduras Mission Trip

Our mission team will be in Subirana, Honduras from March 22nd to March 29th. Please pray for us as we serve the community of Subirana!



It's not too late to give! We are still collecting financial donations to help cover the costs of our medical and dental clinic, as we are preparing to see over 1000 patients. Please mark your donation for "Honduras." We really appreciate your support and could not go to minister to the people of Subirana without you!

Sunday, March 22 - Pray for our team's safe travels today. We expect to fly out of Atlanta at 9:50 am and land in San Pedro Sula, Honduras at 11:15 am. We will then get some lunch before we have a 3-hour drive up a mountain to Subirana. Once we arrive, we will unload all the supplies, sort and count the meds for the medical clinic, and fully set up the medical and dental clinics in the church to prepare for an early start tomorrow morning. Please pray for good sleep tonight and a great first day of ministry tomorrow!

Monday, March 23 - The medical and dental clinics start today! There will be a long line of patients, many of whom walk for hours to come see our teams. Please pray for all the patients that will come to our clinics during the week. Pray that they will receive the care they need and experience the love of Jesus in the process. Our non-medical teams will also begin their ministries today — they will put together blessing bags to deliver to families in need, visit the school to prepare for VBS, and plan the construction projects. Pray for open hearts and for God to have His way this week!



Tuesday, March 24 - Today is our first day of VBS and distributing blessing bags! Please pray that all the children who come to VBS would hear the Gospel and believe. Pray that they would experience the true love of our Father, and that they will want to know Him more. Please also pray for the families we will visit with blessing bags — pray for their health, provision, and that they also would experience God's love today.

Wednesday, March 25 - Pray for our construction team and their potential projects. We don't know yet what they will be doing, and we are flexible as we know that things often change once we are there. Pray that God would guide us to whatever projects He wants done there. Pray that those who see our construction team working will know that they are working for God, and pray for any relationships they may form with the locals while working.

Thursday, March 26 - Pray for our sewing ministry! Melva Stevens restarted the church's former sewing ministry last year, and we're hoping to continue it again this year. Pray that the women who come to learn will use this skill to help provide for their families. Pray that we will form relationships with them and help get them connected to the church if they are not already.

Friday, March 27 - Pray for all of our teams and their ministries as today is their last day in Subirana. Our mission team will also lead a church service this afternoon. Pray for Suzan Boyd as she is preaching the sermon, and pray for God to move all the hearts of those who attend. Pray for Pastor Carlos, his family, and his church, as his ministry continues long after we leave. He leads a thriving church that cares deeply for their community. They also have an amazing youth ministry! Pray that they will continue to grow and reach even more people on the outskirts of their town and surrounding areas.

Saturday, March 28 - Today, our team leaves Subirana and heads to San Pedro Sula. Pray for safe travels down the mountain and some time to rest and reflect on their week of work. Please also pray for our UVMIM team of doctors, dentist, drivers, and interpreters. They host mission teams almost every week all over the country of Honduras. We are exhausted after just one week, and they do this back to back to back! Pray for their ministry, for some rest and renewal before their next team arrives, for their families, and that they will continue to persevere and grow closer to God as they seek to do His Will.



Sunday, March 29 - We fly home today! Please pray for our travels. We fly out of San Pedro Sula at 2:30 pm, Eastern time. We expect to land in Atlanta at 5:50 pm! Pray that our team will get home safely, reflect on their past week and their life-changing experiences, and integrate the best parts of their experience into their daily lives at home. We can't wait to share with you!
