Questions/Topics for this week:

- 1. How have you witnessed Satan try to "sneak" into your life, just as he did with Eve in the Garden of Eden (Genesis 3:1-5)?
- 2. Have you struggled with the thought that God may be holding out on you in any area of your life? If so, explain. Have there been certain tactics you've used to find contentment in those areas?
- 3. How can we combat Satan's lie that God can't be trusted, in our daily lives?

Be Intentional:

This week, consider all the ways Satan uses to lure us away from God in our daily lives. Seek out God's wisdom in discerning those moments and turning to Him in prayer.

Pray:
