Small Group Questions:

3. In what area of your life is God calling you to wholehearted surrender this year? How might community support you in taking that step?

Be Intentional:

Daily 3-Minute Prayer Practice: Each day this week, spend 2–3 minutes asking God to *open your eyes, guard your heart, and send you in love* (Psalm 119:18; Proverbs 4:23; Luke 10:2). Then, identify one practical way to love or serve someone that day, putting your faith into action.

Pray:

Spend time praying together. What are some ways in which you can pray for each other? Take some time in the coming week to explore ways in which you can encourage one another. Remember to share with your group what you are learning about those opportunities and reflect on God's Word as you pray for each other.
