Questions/Topics for this week:

- Explore the contrasting narratives of plotting and preparing in the Gospel of Luke. In what ways can you relate to Judas and the religious leaders' plotting or the disciples' preparation for the Passover? How has recognizing these tendencies impacted your spiritual journey?
- Discuss the action steps presented in the sermon: cultivate intimate connection with Jesus, embracing servanthood, and intentionally sharing communal experiences. Which of these steps resonates with you the most, and how can your small group encourage and support each other in implementing these practices in the coming week?

Be Intentional:

As a group, commit to engaging in a communal experience that strengthens spiritual bonds. This could be participating in a shared prayer time, studying a relevant scripture together, or collectively preparing a simple meal to share. Take time to reflect on how this shared experience enhances your sense of community and spiritual connection.
