The Tension of an Unfinished Ending

Deuteronomy 34:1-12

Faithful Steps When the Promise Feels Out of Reach

- 1. Trust God's <u>purpose</u> over your <u>position</u> (vs. 1-4) Numbers 20; Deuteronomy 3:21-29; 32:48-52
- 2. Live for God's approval, not people's applause (vs. 5-6)
- 3. Obey even when God says "No" or "Not Yet" (vs. 7-8)
 1 Samuel 15:22-23
- 4. Invest in a <u>legacy</u> bigger than you (vs. 9)
- 5. Embrace the weight of both intimacy and accountability
- 6. Let grace write a better ending

 Matthew 17:1-14; Hebrews 11:39-40; Matthew 11:28-30

Small Group Questions:

- 1. When have you stood at the edge of something you hoped for but didn't receive? How did you respond? How did that affect your faith or your view of God?
- 2. Which step from the message challenged you most—and why?
- **3.** How does Moses appearing with Jesus (Matthew 17) reshape your view of disappointments or delays in your life?

Be Intentional:

Name one unfulfilled hope, dream or "almost" in prayer this week—and entrust it to God's timing, grace, and purpose.

Pray:
