In God's kingdom, significance is measured by faithfulness.

Matthew 15:21; 17:20

- **Faithfulness is often found in the minutia of life.**

Faithfulness involves listening to God's voice, honoring him with our choices, and trusting him with the results.

- **Whose voice carries more weight than God's voice in your life?**
Acts 5:29, John 10:27, Proverbs 9:10
- **Honoring God means we give him the place he deserves in our life.**
Psalms 115:1, Matthew 5:16; 6:33
- **Faithfulness shouldn't be dependent on an outcome.**
Proverbs 3:5-6, Matthew 5:11-12; 16:24-25

Small Group Questions:

1. Whose voice (culture, friends, family, fears, etc.) tends to carry more weight than God's in your life? What does it mean for you personally to "hear" and follow God's voice?
2. Brent came up with his own definition for faithfulness. How would you define it for yourself?
3. Shiphrah and Puah had no guarantee of how Pharaoh would respond. What does their example teach us about faithfulness without knowing the results?
