What a Difference Faith Makes!

- Faith <u>trusts</u> that God has a <u>plan</u>.

 Exodus 2:2, Hebrews 11:23, Jeremiah 29:11
- Faith attempts to <u>partner</u> with God in what he is <u>doing</u>. Exodus 2:7, Philippians 2:12–13

Providence is when God takes <u>natural</u> events and weaves <u>supernatural</u> purposes into them.

We are all in <u>need</u> of God's <u>rescue</u>.

Romans 3:23, Colossians 1:13-14, Psalm 40:1-2

Moses' most important lesson: It's foolish to try to rescue ourselves.

Exodus 2:11-15
