- 3. Jesus brings <u>life</u> to the Story Luke 9,22; 1 Corinthians 5; Romans 8:18–23; Galatians 4:4-7 Colossians 3:1-4

Small Group Questions:

- 1. God Writes the Story
 How does knowing that God is writing your story—even through broken or uncertain
 moments—change the way you view your past and present circumstances?
- 2. God Makes a Way Through the Story
 What "wilderness" or challenge are you currently facing where you need to trust God to
 make a way? How can you acknowledge His presence in the midst of it?
- 3. Jesus Brings Life to the Story In what ways does Jesus' life, death, and resurrection bring clarity or hope to the struggles and promises in your life story?

Be Intentional:

This week, write down one way God has been faithful in your story so far, and share it with someone else. Then, identify one current situation where you need to trust Him to make a way and pray specifically for His guidance and provision.

Pray:

Spend time praying together. What are some ways in which you can pray for each other? Take some time in the coming week to explore ways in which you can encourage one another. Remember to share with your group what you are learning about those opportunities and reflect on God's Word as you pray for each other.
