GOD

• He holds <u>justice</u> and <u>mercy</u> in equal tension. Psalm 5:4; 86:15; 89:14; 96:13; 103:10-11

SIN

There are no good guys in this story! Romans 3:9-10, 23

• We are all in need of a <u>rescue</u>.

SUBSTITUTE

It was <u>pure</u>, <u>personal</u>, and a <u>promise</u>. *Exodus 12:3-6, Hebrews 9:22*

SALVATION

"It is finished!" = "Paid in full" John 19:30, Ephesians 2:8-10

SAVIOR

Christ, our <u>Passover</u> <u>Lamb</u>, has been sacrificed for us. 1 Corinthians 5:7, 1 Peter 1:18-19

Small Group Questions:

- 1. Why do you think it's important that God is both a just judge and a merciful rescuer? What would it be like if He were only one of those things?
- 2. How does recognizing our sin actually draw us closer to God instead of pushing us away?
- 3. How does understanding grace change the way you view obedience and good works?
