On Holy Ground...Again!

Exodus 3:12; 19:1-2

When we remember what God has done in our <u>past</u>, we will more clearly see him in our <u>present</u>.

Exodus 19:4; 20:24, Psalm 77:11-12, Luke 22:19

God rescues us for the purpose of relationship.

Exodus 19:5, Genesis 3:8-9, Matthew 15:8, Hebrews 13:5

- He pledges himself to us with a <u>covenant</u>, not a <u>contract</u>.
- Obey = Shema: to trust in a voice

God gives us a new identity.

Exodus 19:5-6, 2 Corinthians 5:17, Galatians 5:22-23

Treasured Possession

• We will stop striving for approval and rest in his love.

Kingdom of Priests

We will stop living for <u>ourselves</u> and start living for <u>others</u>.

Holy Nation

• We will stop conforming to the culture and start being transformed by God's spirit.

Small Group Questions:

- 1. Have you ever revisited a place or moment in your life where God had clearly met you before? How did that experience impact your faith in the present?
- 2. What are some ways we can practice remembering God's faithfulness in our daily lives?
- 3. Why do you think we so easily drift from relationship with God to religious performance for God?
