Why Many Miss the Point:

God doesn't give rules to rescue us, He rescues us to form us

How the Ten Form Us:

- 1. They form us into a new kind of society
- 2. They form us into people who reflect God's character.
- 3. They form us into a people who show God to the world
- 4. They form the foundation of a covenant relationship
- 5. They form us into a people who live whole-life faith

Jesus and the Ten

- Jesus <u>fulfilled</u> the Law Matthew 5:17-18
- Jesus <u>summarized</u> the Law *Matthew 22:35-40*
- Jesus <u>followed</u> the law Mark 10:17-22

God rescued you to form you—this week, I will let Him shape my .

Small Group Questions:

- 1. How does knowing that you are God's "treasured possession" change the way you view the Ten Commandments?
- 2. In what areas of your life do you feel the Ten Words shaping your character, relationships, or choices? Where might God be calling you to grow?
- 3. How can you integrate your faith into both spiritual and social areas of your life this week, reflecting God to those around you?

Remember to share with your group what you are learning about those opportunities and reflect on God's Word as you pray for each other.
