Small Group Questions:

1. When you think about God “moving in” with His people, what image or emotion comes to mind for you personally? Does it feel comforting, challenging, surprising, or something else?
2. Where do you sense God inviting you to “make room” for His presence this week? Is there a distraction to set aside, a rhythm to start, or a place in your life where you need to slow down and dwell with Him?
3. If we are God’s mobile tabernacles, what would someone learn about God by watching your life right now? Does your life reveal His compassion, holiness, patience, generosity, peace, or something else?

Be Intentional:

This week, choose one 10-minute block every day to “abide” — to simply sit with God’s presence. No agenda. No list. Just awareness.

Use this prayer: “Lord, You desire to dwell with me. Help me dwell with You.”

Pray:

Spend time praying together. What are some ways in which you can pray for each other? Take some time in the coming week to explore ways in which you can encourage one another. Remember to share with your group what you are learning about those opportunities and reflect on God’s Word as you pray for each other.
