- **Is more concerned with our long-term character than our short-term happiness.**
- **Will eventually put right everything that’s gone awry.**

Small Group Questions:

1. When was a time when you found it difficult to trust in God's faithfulness. What made it hard to trust in that moment?
2. Why do you think spiritual growth so often happens through discomfort rather than comfort?
3. How does God's mercy toward repentant sinners shape the way you view his justice? How does 2 Timothy 2:13 challenge you or comfort you?

Be Intentional:

Trust grows by remembering who God has proven himself to be. Journal about a way God has been faithful to you in the past. Then write a prayer about a current situation where you need God to help you have more faith.

Pray:

Pray for the courage to trust God more deeply, especially in areas where fear, doubt, or past wounds make faith feel risky. Explore ways you can encourage one another. Remember to share with your group what you are learning about yourself and God's word, so you can best continue praying for each other.
