**Wind** *John 3:1-9*

### **Holy Spirit Awareness**

- *Spirit/ ruach* means wind and breath

### **Holy Spirit Encounter**

*John 3:1-9; Ezekiel 36:25–27; Titus 3:5*

- You don't need a better version of your old life you need an entirely new life.

### **2 Movements of the Holy Spirit**

#### **1. The Spirit transforms you inwardly**

*2 Corinthians 3:18; Galatians 5*

#### **2. The Spirit moves you outwardly**

*Acts 2:1-4; Genesis 1:1-2; Exodus 14:21-22; Mark 6:45-56*

- The Spirit that calls you forward is the same Spirit that makes a way

### **Evidence of the Holy Spirit**

*2 Peter 1:20-21*

### Small Group Questions:

1. Awareness of the Spirit (ruach = wind/breath)  
Where in your life are you most aware—or least aware—of the Holy Spirit's presence and movement right now?
2. Inward Transformation (*2 Corinthians 3:18; Galatians 5*)  
Where have you seen (or resisted) the Spirit changing your heart, desires, or character recently?
3. Outward Movement & Trust (*Acts 2; Exodus 14; Mark 6*)  
Where might God be inviting you to trust His leading instead of trying to control the outcome?

### Be Intentional:

This week, practice **daily surrender in one specific area**:

Each day pray: "Holy Spirit, I release control. Make me new. Lead me."

Then choose **one moment each day** to pause and ask: "Holy Spirit, what are You doing here?"

Act on whatever gentle prompting, conviction, or direction you sense—especially in small acts of obedience.

### Pray:

Spend time praying together. What are some ways in which you can pray for each other? Take some time in the coming week to explore ways in which you can encourage one another. Remember to share with your group what you are learning about those opportunities and reflect on God's Word as you pray for each other.
