**How do you know when the Holy Spirit is leading, and you should follow?**

*Psalm 23:3; Exodus 13:21; 40:36-37; Isaiah 63:11-14*

**The Holy Spirit guides us by his verse and his voice.**

*Psalm 119:105; Romans 12:2; John 10:27*

- God wants the norm of our life to be a pattern of obedience to what he's already spoken through scripture.
- God never contradicts himself.

**How to hear when the Spirit speaks:**

*Romans 8:14; Psalm 139:23-24; Hebrews 10:25*

- Prioritize God's ways over culture's ways.
- Be open and ready to follow.
- Seek the council of other believers.

**God's biggest concern is who we are becoming, not where we are going.**

**Small Group Questions:**

1. What do you think it means to be "led by the Spirit"?
2. The sermon stated, "The Holy Spirit guides us by his verse and his voice." Why is it important to keep those two together?
3. Have you ever felt prompted by the Holy Spirit to do something? What happened when you obeyed or didn't obey?
