God's Story of Rahab

Joshua 2 and 6

How God Rewrites a Story

1. Grace pursues

Genesis 3:9

- God moves toward people everyone else assumes are too far gone

2. Faith responds

Joshua 2:8-11; Hebrews 11:31

- Faith is trusting enough to say yes to what God has revealed

3. Hope holds on

Joshua 2:15-18,6:17,22-25; Hebrews 11:1-2,39; Ephesians 2:8-10; James 2:25-26; Matthew 1:5

- Hope holds onto God's promise while waiting for God's timing

4. Jesus completes

- Your past is part of your story, but it is not the truest thing about you

Small Group Questions

1. What labels, failures, or past experiences have felt like walls in your life, convincing you that your story could never change? Which of those labels is hardest to let go of?
2. Rahab heard about God, believed, and responded in faith. What is one area of your life where God is inviting you to trust Him or say "yes" to Him right now?
3. Rahab held onto the scarlet cord while she waited for God's promise to be fulfilled. What are you currently waiting on God for, and what would it look like to hold onto hope this week?

Be Intentional

Identify one part of your story you have believed God cannot redeem, and surrender it to Jesus in prayer every day this week. Ask God to help you stop defining yourself by your past and begin seeing yourself through His grace.
