The Holy Spirit anoints all believers...

1 John 2:20; Titus 3:6; Acts 2:17

- **Christian = An anointed one who follows the anointed One.**

Setting us apart for God's purposes...

Ephesians 2:10; 1 Peter 2:9

- **The point of our life is to point others to Jesus.**

Equipping us to serve his mission with spiritual gifts.

1 Corinthians 12-14; Romans 12:6

Spiritual gifts...

Romans 12:6-8; 1 Corinthians 12:8-10; 28-30; Ephesians 4:11-12; 1 Peter 4:10-11.

- **Glorify God and bless others**
- **Are administered in love**
- **Are not an indication of spiritual maturity**

The Holy Spirit's anointing moves us from spectators to servants.
