The kind of faith that amazes Jesus:

Mark 6:6; Luke 7:9

- **Requires humility.**
Matthew 5:3; John 1:27; Ephesians 2:8-9
- **Trusts in a relationship, not in spiritual formulas.**
Philippians 3:8–9; Matthew 11:28-30
- **Trusts in his authority.**
James 2:19; Matthew 28:18; Psalm 111:7-8
- **Trusts that God is at work even when he doesn't feel present.**
Hebrews 11:1; Romans 8:28, 38-39
- **Is available to anyone.**

John 3:16; Romans 10:9-13

Small Group Questions:

1. How can pride subtly affect the way we approach God? What would it look like for you to approach God with greater humility this week?
2. Have you ever caught yourself trusting in your spiritual performance more than in Christ himself? What's the difference between having religious habits and having a relationship with Jesus?
3. Share a time when you later realized God was working even though you couldn't see it at the time.

Be Intentional:

Is there an area of your life where you know what Jesus says, but have struggled to obey? What makes obedience difficult?

Pray:

Spend time praying together. What are some ways in which you can pray for each other? Take some time in the coming week to explore ways in which you can encourage one another. Remember to share with your group what you are learning about those opportunities and reflect on God's Word as you pray for each other.
