Because he did not grow up in an Orthodox Jewish home, Igal has tried a variety of religions including Judaism, Islam, and even Buddhism, but, of course, none of these has brought peace to his heart. Although Igal did not accept Christ that day, I believe that perhaps for the very first time, he was able to see himself as a sinner. Please pray that God will send others to water the seed that was sown in his heart and that Igal will one day accept Jesus Christ as his Savior.
