Dear Pastor and friends,

Sometimes losing a member is gaining a ministry. A few years ago, Obed Chacón moved back to the ranch he has in the country. He had been in our church for many years and had served as a deacon and teacher. The city nearest to the ranch is Cintalapa, one of the larger towns in our state of Chiapas. Naturally, he witnessed to anyone who would listen and eventually formed a Bible study group with several converts. On several occasions he had asked me about forming a mission there. I was very receptive to the idea, but did not have the laborers available. However, in our annual day of "Unity in Missions" in January more of our members committed themselves to local missionary team service. On March 2 we made our exploratory trip to get to know the field and meet the Christians there. On March 3 the new "Bread of Life Bible Baptist Mission" was formed in Cintalapa, Chiapas. Some of our most experienced leaders took charge of this new work. Please pray for them as we sow the seed and build a church in this new region.

The main construction of the Bible College and School is nearing groundbreaking day. The original large room where our church had a "re-beginning" after losing all of the original church properties was in the plan for demolition. However, I figured out a way to build a wall all the way to the roof inside the original wall that was falling down and was able to save that useful (and for us, historical) room.

The next step will be to dig and construct a very large 4750 gallon cistern in order to have an adequate water supply for the construction, and later for the complex. Many severe problems in other ministries have distracted me and impeded this project. Please pray that the grace of God will strengthened, sustain and guide us.
