I guess over 3000 units. People are literally walking to church. Of course no other church of any kind (that I know of) in our immediate area. So almost every service a new visitor comes from there. When we first came out here with no water, no electricity and only a few neighbors (ranches) we did not even consider something like this for the future. However, God knew it all in advance. Oh how important it is for us to be guided by His Spirit and will. We are so fortunate to have many praying for us and thereby God’s grace upon us.

It took me almost 20 years to understand that God had BIG plans for our ministry here at the ranch. Some years back a friend of our ministry, investor and builder (Bro Mike) asked me why we didn’t have a “Master Plan”? At that time, it seemed unnecessary to me, but I now see that he was right. Sunday evening service a man stood and gave testimony on how a tract left at his door brought him back to the fold. He was very grateful. Then a visitor from last week caught my eye, George looked like one of my old buddies (if you know what I mean). We chatted for a moment and I prayed for him after the service. He returned this week and after service he shared his story. Oh how people need the Lord! But God help me not to forget or be insensitive because people also need other people! Just a few kind words can change a person’s destiny. So many here with spiritual and emotional needs.

I don’t have the numbers but you know by now that we always have folks saved every week and baptisms. We are also working hard on expanding our personal discipleship program. I am training a group of about 80 to take the next step which is adopt a disciple and help him or her become a mentor for others.
